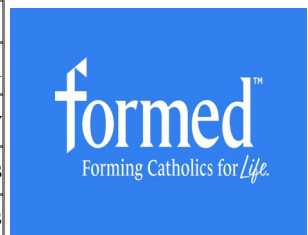

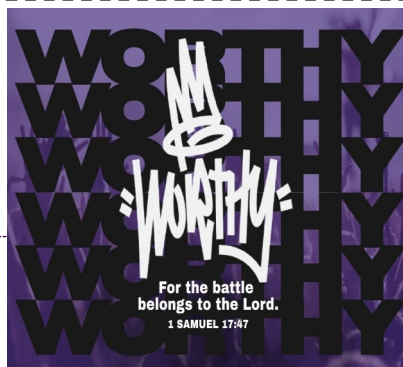

St. Bruno Fundraising Update

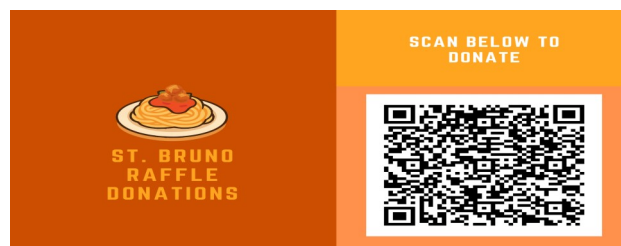
