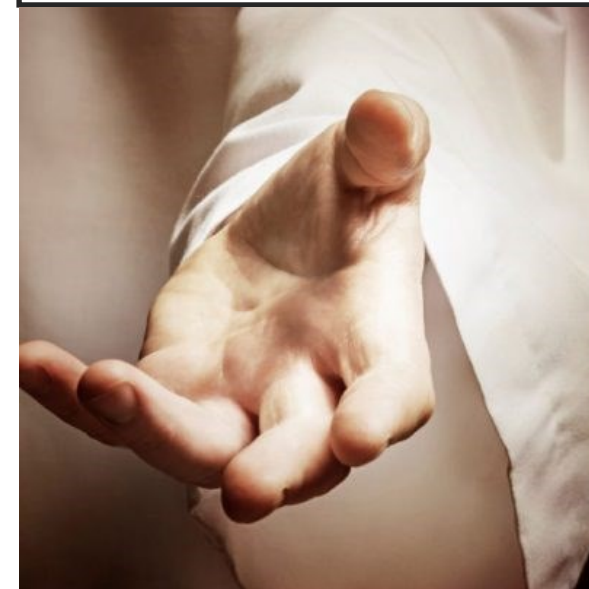

- ◇ How will I touch Jesus, either really or virtually, in touching another?

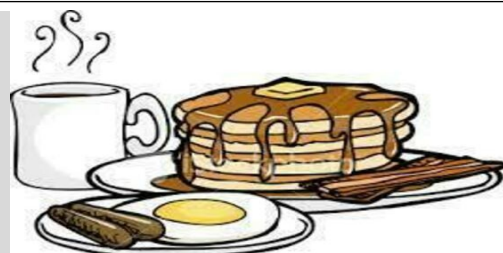
